Rules

No bikes on the Churchill Grounds

3 points for a win 1 point for a draw

20 minute halves

Unlimited rolling subs

Girls' goals count for 2

No slide-tackles - see right (image from http://soccerprose.com).

Roll-ins from the side (instead of kick-ins)

Pass-back's allowed

No-one's allowed in the D apart from the keeper - the penalty for entering the D (with a bit of latitude) is a penalty from a metre from the D edge.

No offsides

Overhead balls allowed

Unclear outs to the benefit of the defending team.

The games are self-reffed (until the finals), so anyone who feels they've been fouled should say so and we all should go with it a perhaps with a bit more discretion in the attacking half.

If this gets contentious, then we can sort out a refereeing roster, which would mean each team would have a game to ref every fortnight.

But we reckon we'll be able to keep it friendly and sort out the refereeing ourselves - we'll see how it goes.

The Cavendish Football Kit is kept at stores. Home teams are responsible for picking it up and returning it.

All fixture amendments to be handled by team captains.

Teams that can't make a fixture lose 3-0.

Home teams are responsible for time-keeping.

All games played on Churchill College grounds (just across the road from the Cavendish). The groundsmen there are top blokes - all they ask is that we don't ride bikes on to the fields.

Team captains to email the result to Nij (nnl20) after the game - results will be posted on the Purple Shin Website.

Games to be played in a spirit befitting people who spend much time in a lab or at a desk.

Finals Rules

No bikes on the Churchill Grounds

20 minute halves

If the scores are level after 40 minutes of play, each team takes off one player. At this point the keeper is allowed out of the D, but no players (with the exception of the defending keeper) are allowed in the D.

The team to score first wins (ie. golden goal). If the scores are level after 5 minutes, both teams take another player off. This continues until there is only one player left from each team – and the game continues until one team scores.
